Information Security

CCS takes the security of your personal and financial information very seriously and we take reasonable measures to safeguard your information consistent with our Privacy Policy. Our network is composed of access-controlled measures, security monitoring tools, vulnerability management program, SSL encryption, scheduled network scans, and internal and external penetration tests. When it is necessary for our service providers to have access to your information, we expect the same level of data security, integrity and confidentiality standards as CCS itself provides. Additionally, we conduct security awareness training for our staff and volunteers.

While CCS uses its best efforts to maintain this level of security across all of our systems we cannot guarantee or warrant that our systems or our service providers are not vulnerable to viruses, hacking or other security threats.
