The sealed auction bid will be conducted as follows:

1. The bidding window shall open June 23, 2021 and continue until July 12, 2021.
2. Any bids received after July 12, 2021 at 5:00 P.M. shall not be deemed valid bids.
3. There will be reserve placed on the Can-Am of Nine Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$9,500.00) (hereinafter referred to as the "Reserve Price"). The original price paid by the Council for the Can-Am was \$15, 764.
4. Any bids for less than the Reserve Price shall not be deemed valid bids.
5. All bids shall be submitted to Bennett, Weber & Hermstad, LLP, in a sealed envelope, by mail or hand delivery at the following address:

7. By submitting a bid, you agree to allow the Council of Community Services to publicly announce your name, and winning bid amount.
8. On July 12th, 2021, Bennett, Weber & Hermstad, LLP and members of Council of Community Services shall open the bids that have been submitted with the highest bidder being declared the winner.
9. The winning bidder will be contacted via telephone and email using the information provided in their bids.
10. The winner shall have until 5:00 P.M. on July 16th, 2021, to tender payment to the Council of Community services. If payment is not received, or the Council is unable to contact the highest bidder. the second highest bidder shall be declared the winner.
11. In the event of tie, the first bid received shall be deemed the higher bidder. Whether a bid is a valid bid, is the sole discretion of the Council of Community Services.
12. The dating of valid bids is in the sole discretion of the Council of Community Services.
